The Village of Pinecrest Police Department Operations Division is requesting that remaining LETF funds be allocated for the purchase of (4) Level 4 Ballistic Shields.

Cost per Ballistic Shield unit: \$5,420.00

With recent active shooter events that have occurred around the country, it has become even more important to equip first responding officers with additional ballistic protection that will give patrol officers the ability to quickly and safely bring these terrible acts to an end when they do arise. The Operations Division is requesting Ballistic Shields that are stand-alone Level IV rifle rated up to 7.62 x 63, which encompasses the more commonly used 223 caliber rifle ammunition. It should be noted that 223 caliber rifles have been used in the last (5) mass shootings.
