

**RESOLUTION NO. 2023-**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF PINECREST,  
FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER  
TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH GARBER FLEET  
SALES FOR POLICE VEHICLES; PROVIDING FOR AN  
EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the Village Council approved the purchase police vehicles and accompanying equipment through the collective bargaining agreement (CBA) with the Police Benevolent Association representing the Police Officers and Police Sergeants; and

WHEREAS, the vehicles are needed to fulfill the take-home vehicle requirement in the CBA;

WHEREAS, Florida Sheriffs Association conducted a competitive bidding process for the procurement of Police Vehicles and awarded a bid to Garber Fleet Sales; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-287 of the Code of Ordinances, the Village Manager is authorized to execute contracts, as entered into by other governmental authorities, provided that the governmental authority has followed a competitive bidding procedure leading to the award of the bid or contract in question;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF PINECREST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Village Council hereby authorizes the Village Manager, pursuant to Section 2-287 of the Code of Ordinances, to “piggyback” on an existing contract between Florida Sheriffs Association and Garber Fleet Sales (Contract/Bid No. FSA20-VEL 28.0), and enter into an agreement with Garber Fleet Sales; for police vehicles.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

RE: Request for expenditure

Pursuant to council approval of the current collective bargaining agreements (CBA) with the Police Benevolent Association representing the Police Officers and Police Sergeants, I am requesting to purchase 15 police vehicles and accompanying equipment. These vehicles are needed to fulfill the take-home vehicle requirement in the CBA. The following expenditures are over \$50,000 and pursuant to our purchasing policy require council approval.

Nine of these vehicles were not included in the FY 23 budget and will require a budget amendment of 446,140.00 (vehicles) and \$45,710.00 (cameras) for a total of \$491,850.00
